HISTORY OF THE 356 REGISTRY

The 356 Registry was Founded in Ohio in 1974. The organizer and prime mover was Jerry Keyser. Jerry recognized the need for an organization to further the interests of 356 enthusiasts. His vision, as stated in a flier that preceded the first issue of the 356 Registry magazine, was "To preserve and perpetuate the vintage 356 series Porsche through an organization of owners, enthusiasts, and other interested parties."

Jerry ran an ad in Road and Track to solicit support. One of the early responders to the ad was Vic Skirmants. Vic had previously developed a list of individuals who were interested in the early 356s. Vic turned over his list of names to Jerry to help get the 356 Registry started. Jerry soon issued Vol. 1, No. 1 of the 356 Registry magazine.

The first 356 Holiday was organized by Bob and Ginny Gummow. It was held at the Clock Tower Inn in Rockford, Illinois on August 30-31, 1975. This first event had twenty-one registrants along with spouses and children. The event was so successful that planning for the second event was underway before the first event was over.

The 356 Registry has now grown to over 4,500 enthusiastic members, including 356 owners from many different countries. It is expected that the Club will continue to grow and prosper!

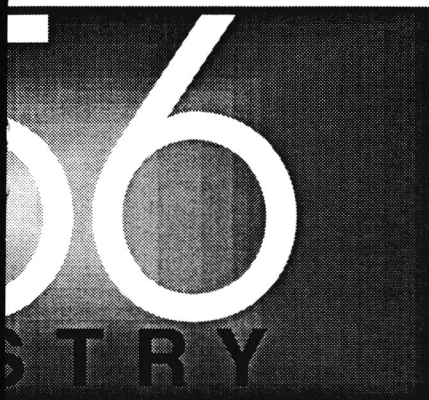

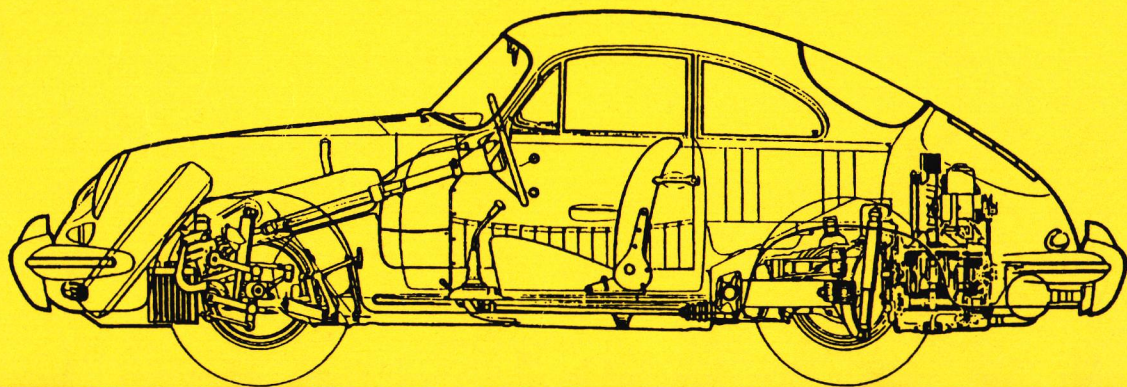


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
