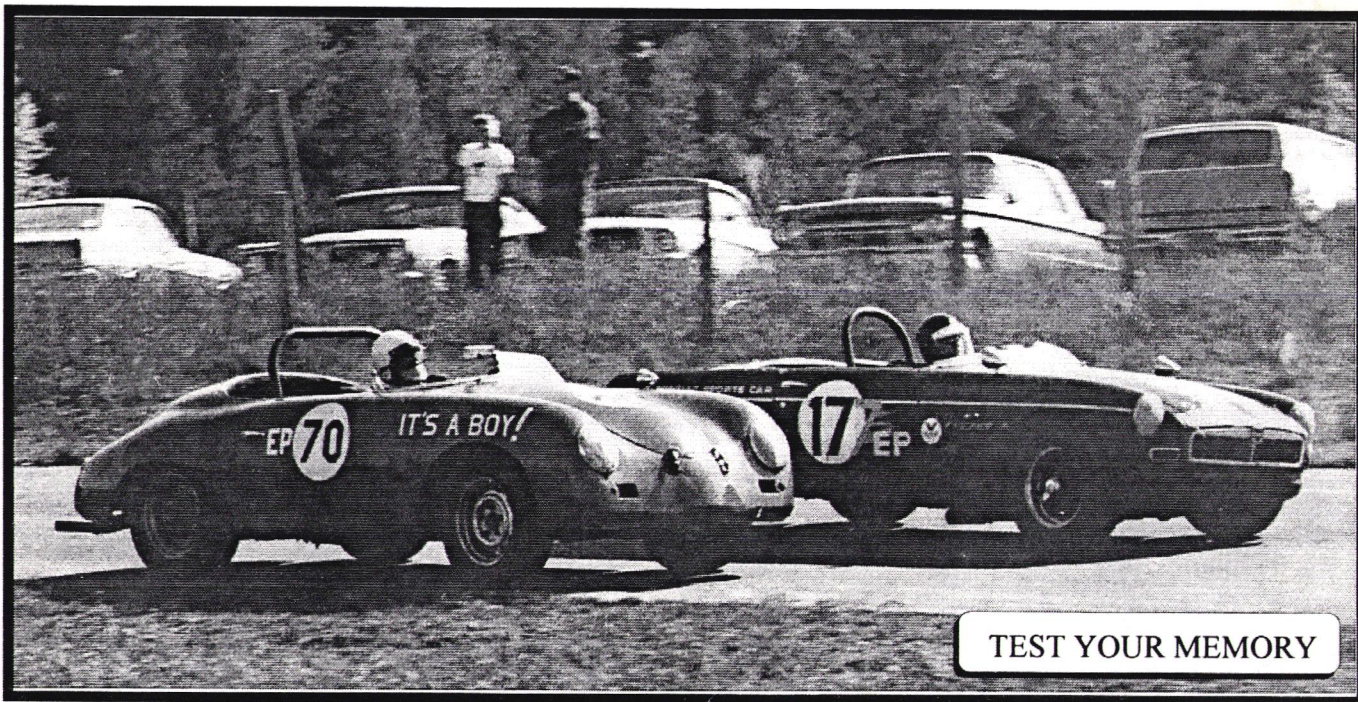
President's Message

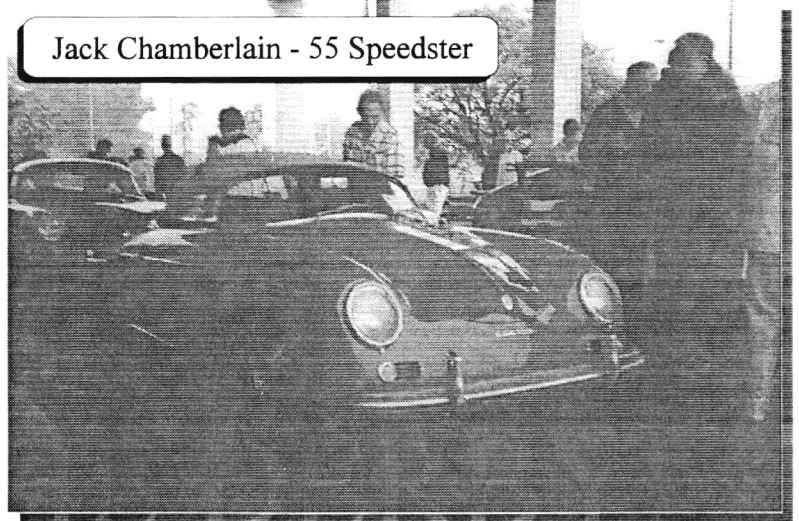
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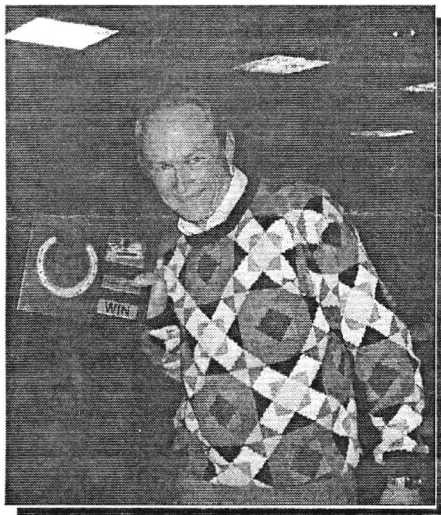

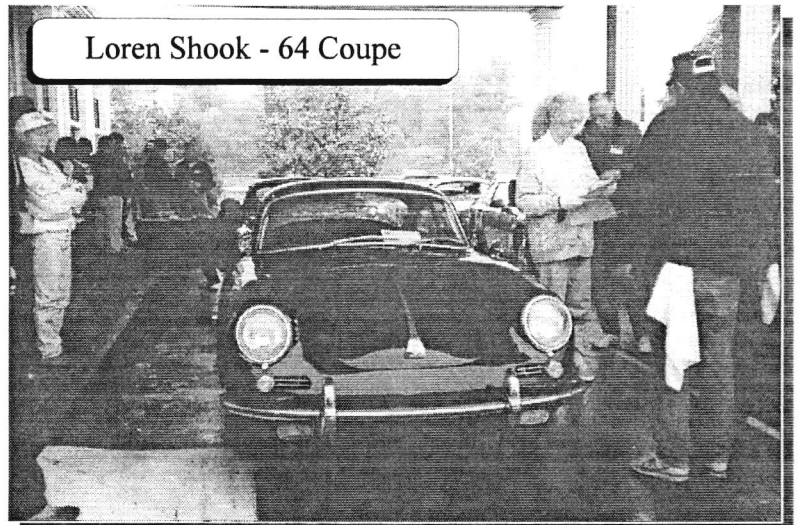

Jack Chamberlain - 55 Speedster



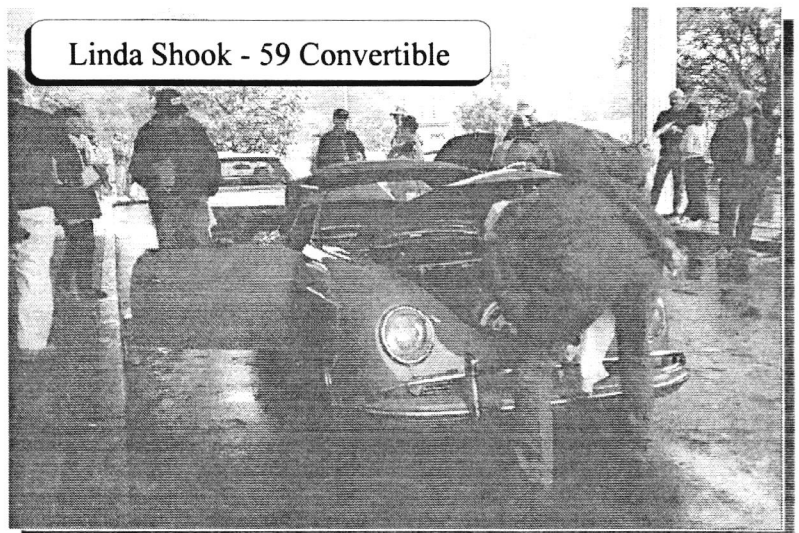

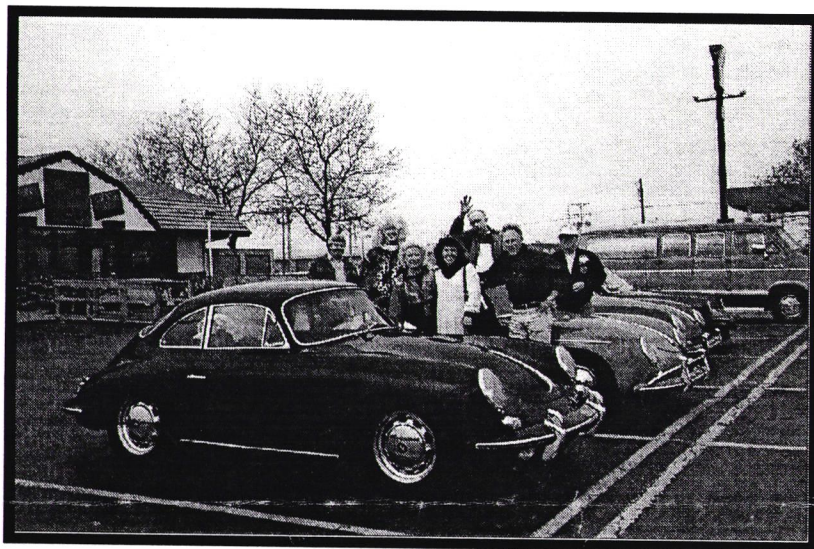

THING - A COVETED BATHTUB ON WHEELS OR...Older Porsches make owners feel like, if not look like James Dean. Newer Porsches shout mid-life crisis.

WHAT? the Porsche 356, an antique bathtub-shaped sports car made in various permutations, both coupes and convertibles, from 1948 to 1965. Highly valued by car collectors: 76,300 were built, and about 20,000 are thought to remain on the road. The Porsche 356 registry has over 4,000 members, some who own several models. Celebrity owners include Jerry Seinfeld (a blue 1958 Speedster) and Ralph Lauren (a black 1959 Speedster).

PRONUNCIATION: PORSH-ah, please. Not PORSH.

WHERE ARE THEY DRIVEN? On television (most notably by the teen icon and James Dean clone Luke Perry in "Beverly Hills 90210"). In films (Michael J. Fox drove one in "Doc Hollywood." So did Nick Nolte and Eddie Murphy in "48 Hours"). In music videos (Huey Lewis in "I Want a New Drug"). Other credits include a recent commercial for 1-800-COLLECT and the PBS mini-series "Tales of the City." The Porsche 356 also had a bit part in the movie "BULLITT," the seminal car-crash movie. "After Steve McQueen crashed the Mustang, he meets some girl, and

she has a 356 cabriolet, and she hauls him around," said Clark Anderson of San Jose, California, a member of the Porsche Club of America's national committee and a 356 expert.

WHY? They evoke a rebellious "On the Road" nostalgia without making the driver look like a Beat-era greaser (imagine a '57 Chevy) or just plain cool.

WHY ELSE? Older Porsches make owners feel like, if not look like James Dean. Newer Porsches shout mid-life crisis.

WHY JAMES DEAN? James Dean, who was an amateur race car driver, owned a white 356 Speedster but found it a trifle

slow. So, he traded up to a silver Porsche Spyder 550, a limited-series racing car with an aluminum body and a bigger engine. On September 30, 1955, in Cholame, California, Dean was killed in the Spyder when it struck a car driven by Donald Turnipseed, a California Polytechnic student. Mr Turnipseed drove a 1950 Ford. He lived.

HISTORY: Built in an era when cars were large and heavy, the lightweight Porsche was one of the first mass-produced sports cars. It was also the first production car made by Dr. Ferdinand Porsche, the legendary designer who created the Volkswagen after his release from prison in 1947. He was convicted by the French of siding the German war effort; he designed the Tiger tank.) The designation 356 derives from the fact that it was Porsche's 356th design. The

356 models were replaced by the 911 series, which is still in production.

COST: Originally priced under \$3,00 and obtainable 15 years ago for as little as \$1,500 (running), models in good condition now sell from \$25,000 to \$60,000, with some fetching as much as \$100,000. A few rare Spyders have sold for \$1 million. James Dean's Speedster, in a private collection, may be as close to priceless as a car can get.

SPECS: Early-production models had a rear-mounted, 35 horsepower engine, a steel body, minimum trim, and a top speed of 85 miles per hour. Later models had larger engines.

WHAT RALPH NADER WOULD NOTICE: "Trailing throttle oversteer," a phenomenon in early models that occurred when a driver

abruptly took his foot off the gas pedal - a natural reaction - when rounding a curve too fast. When this happened, the rear end of the car swung around to the front.

OTHER SHORTCOMINGS: Some early models lacked gas gauges. "You had a little wooden stick that you stuck in the tank," Mr. Anderson said. "But you also had a reserve gas tank. In the convertibles, the top wasn't much use either. "It was called an all-weather," Mr. Anderson said. "That meant that all the weather on the outside came inside."
